Holy Week

On Palm Sunday, April 1, the worship service will begin with the children carrying palms into the service. Holy Communion will be served during worship. Special music will be provided by the choir. There will be a Potluck Dinner following the worship service.

During Holy Week, visitation and communion will be taken to shut-ins. If you have someone who would like communion taken to them, please call your request to the church office.

A Prayer Vigil will be held in the chapel on Good Friday, April 6, from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. This is a special time of study and prayer in the quietness of God's presence. A sign-up sheet is placed in the Narthex to choose a time that is convenient for you.

A Good Friday service is scheduled for 7 p.m. in the sanctuary. This will be a healing service for all as we consider the passion and sacrifice that Jesus gave for each of us.

Easter Sunday morning will begin with the youth worship service at 8 a.m. The Havelock youth will be in charge. A time for coffee and rolls will follow between services.

Easter Sunday Service at 9:30 a.m.

Countdown to resurrection followed by the Flowering of the Cross will start the service. Music will be provided by the Adult and Youth Choirs, lilies to decorate the sanctuary and a special message by Pastor Chuck as we celebrate the joy of spring and the promise of everlasting life in Jesus.

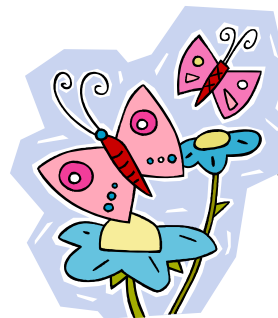
HUMW April General Meeting

Countdown to Ground Zero A Celebration of Easter

As a people of faith, during the six weeks of lent, we have been preparing for our Easter celebration with an in-depth look at the last 12 hours of Jesus' life. We are counting down the hours to Easter Sunday when we will celebrate the fact of faith that death and sin have been destroyed and that "all things have been made new".

During Holy Week, on Good Friday, we will have a special healing service at 7 pm, in the Sanctuary; The Healing Service is a special service of the United Methodist Church, where we anoint the sick with oil according to the Scriptures and lift, them up to God's highest good. James 5:14-15 reads, "Are any among you sick? They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray for them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord. The prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise them up; and anyone, who has committed sins, will be forgiven."

We believe that Christ died and rose again to bring redemption to the whole person, both physical and spiritual. We invite you to bring all those sick and in distress to this service on Good Friday and to celebrate our Lord's resurrection on Easter Sunday.
