PASTOR'S NOTE

Healing Wounded Relationships A Special Lenten Focus

We were created to be in relationship - with God, with others and with the world. Relationships are difficult. They are often our greatest source of both joy and pain. Sometimes relationships wound us. This is true for all living things in God's creation. In creation physical environments often change dramatically. When this happens, life forms are wounded. They either adapt to the new environment or they die. When they adapt, they become stronger. They actually learn to survive from their woundedness.

This is true of our spiritual and relational life as well. We wound each other in relationships, sometimes intentionally and sometimes unintentionally. We either learn to adapt in the relationship or the relationship dies. We are wounded by our separation from God and his purpose for us. The Bible calls this sin.

Recovery in our relationships and our "sin sickness" is not about returning to a former desired state but about recreating our relationships and especially our relationship with God.

The events leading up to the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus give us an opportunity to examine destructive patterns in relationships both with others and with God. We can also gain great insight into healing those relationships. During lent and through Easter, we will be offering opportunities for healing those relationships through a special worship series and Bible study.
