

#### FEBRUARY 2013 LENTEN STUDY AND SERMON SERIES

This Lenten season The Havelock United Methodist Church will coordinate a Sunday morning worship series with a Wednesday night Bible Study based on a book and video study series by Adam Hamilton entitled "The Way: Walking in the



footsteps of Jesus" Adam Hamilton presents historical information, archaeological data, and stories of faith in following the footsteps of Jesus from his baptism in the Jordan River to the heart of his ministry, including the people he loved, the parables he taught, the enemies he made, and the healing he brought to this world then and today.

This 40-day church wide emphasis during lent is another way we live out our mission statement "to provide a spiritual community of loving friends, growing together in God's truth and reaching out to those in need."

If you are new to the Havelock Church, this is an opportunity for you to connect to others in the church and most importantly to learn about what the message of Jesus is all about.

Please consider inviting a friend or neighbor to participate with you in both the worship experience on the Sundays of Lent and also the Wednesday night small group studies. THE WORSHIP SERIES will begin on Sunday, February 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 am through Easter Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup>.

THE SIX-WEEK BIBLE STUDY begins on Wednesday, February 20<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 pm – 8:15 pm and will be held in Fellowship Hall.

The hard cover book "The Way" by Adam Hamilton will be available at a cost of \$11.96 and devotionals for each of the 40 days of Lent entitled "The Way: 40 Days of Reflection", also by Adam Hamilton, is available at a cost of \$6.29 plus a small charge for shipping.
