Dear Friends in Christ, Revelations 5:11-14 says: "Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels surrounding the throne and the living creatures and the elders; they numbered ten thousand times ten thousand and thousands of thousands, singing with full voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slaughtered to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"
