Dear Havelock UMW Members,

One label at a time we are changing the lives of young people. At mealtime, don't forget Epworth Village, Inc. Also, remember how important you are to the success of our program! Once again, we are asking you to save the following brands so that we can continue to enhance our family-centered treatment in a variety of ways. As of February 2007 we have collected 145,595 label points through your efforts!

For the Campbell's Labels for Education program: Watch for products worth 5 points - specially marked Condensed Soups (10 oz.) and other selected Campbell's products. We need the UPC code and 5 point symbol.

Wilderness Roads

We at the Havelock Church are spending the summer investigating the Book of Acts and learning how we can be a first century church in the twenty-first century. Last Sunday we journeyed metaphorically with Phillip down the wilderness road from Jerusalem to Gaza and discovered how we can find ministry on wilderness roads.

Havelock United Methodist is a church that is open to all persons and does its best to reach those in our community that are traveling on wilderness roads. Some of those come from roads of addiction and attend AA and NA meetings in the church. Some will be coming to the Fourth of July Celebration who are lost on wilderness roads. Pray that our church community will be welcoming and be the kind of place where felt needs are met. We are hoping that children attending our celebration will be attracted to our VBS, which is scheduled for the week following the celebration event where we will have information available.

The Healing Circle project continues to work on their proposal to work with at risk women and children using our facility. They have a preliminary blueprint of remodeling that they would like to do that they will be presented to a building committee that is being appointed by the Board of Trustees. No final decisions will be made on this project until the District Committee on Building reviews the plans and a written vote is taken at the Havelock Church at a church-wide conference. I am proud of our church and the willingness to attempt ministry on wilderness roads. I believe that, just like Phillip, the Spirit is calling us to wilderness roads.
