## PASTOR'S NOTE

#### EXPERIENCING GOD THROUGH CONFIRMATION **ARE YOU CONFIRMED?**

On Sunday, October 26<sup>th</sup> we had the joy of receiving six young people into church membership through confirmation: Three at the Havelock Church and three at the Eagle Church. In addition, we observed the sacrament of baptism at both churches. At Havelock, one of our confirmation students received baptism and in Eagle, a 15 year old young man who recently started attending church accepted Christ as Savior and was baptized. We also received 3 new adult members, two at Havelock and one at Eagle. We, along with the angels in heaven were rejoicing!

The service at both churches was centered around knowing God through our experiences, ending a four part worship series on the Wesleyan Quadrilateral. For those who are unfamiliar with this term, it represents four ways of coming to understand God as represented in John Wesley's writings and theology. The four ways are tradition, scripture, reason and experience.

Confirmation is not a one-time event but a continuing process whereby we reaffirm and confirm our relationship with Jesus Christ. This service was a wonderful opportunity for the faith communities at Havelock and Eagle to "confirm" their continued experience and relationship with Jesus Christ through the working of the Holy Spirit.

Another wonderful way that we experienced God was through Danielle Picotte who received her Bible in the service at the Havelock Church along with Tiffany Harris, one of our confirmation students. Danielle first came to the Havelock church this summer during Vacation Bible School. We then invited her to join the children's choir in September and be a part of Sunday school. During Sunday school she mentioned that she would like to have her own Bible. Danielle lives across the street from the church. On Sunday, October 19th, Danielle brought 3 of her friends with her to Sunday school. Taylor Swenson one of our children also brought her best friend to church with her on the same Sunday. God's Spirit is definitely at work in both the Havelock and the Eagle United Methodist Churches. We praise God as he continues to confirm His presence among us.

#### Financial Report - October 19, 2008

Operating Budget Needs Year to Date for 2008 Receipts for Operating Budget Year to Date Shortfall:	\$79,674 79,562 \$112
Apportionment Obligation 2008	\$22,885
Apportionments Received	8,000
Remaining obligation	\$14,885

The trustees have reported that the church must replace the flat roof over much of the church, as it cannot be repaired further. The current bids are between \$37,000 and \$49,000. The Board of Trustees have decided to try and raise a minimum of \$15,000 through congregational pledges and are working on funding the remainder of the cost with the assistance of the Finance Committee.

#### **Holiday Service Projects**

Winter is approaching real fast so once again during the month of November we will collect children's stocking caps, mittens or gloves, and socks for the Head Start program. There will be a Christmas tree set back in the Narthex to put your items on. This will run through the month of November.


