The services will be offered at a rate of \$35 per session.

This partnership offers individuals and families the chance to receive counseling services that will be designed to fit their needs and all who seek counseling will be welcomed. Choices staff of licensed, professional counselors will be able to offer help in a wide range of areas such as mental health issues, addictions, compulsive gambling, marriage and family, anger management, overspending, budgeting and much more.
