Financial Update through May 2025

Totals are year to date -Giving: \$50,890.78

Interest "Ess" Investment: \$11,385.52

Total Income: \$62,276.30 Expenses: \$61,779.81

I had not paid the pastor pension & benefits yet in June, however I had a generous church member write a check on 6/22 to cover that. We had \$1,339 in the account at the end of May. As of 6/21 we have \$629 in the account and I need \$3,862 by month end to cover payroll.

If we do not have have offerings the next 2 Sundays that cover the payroll need, I will have to withdraw from Ameritas – American Funds – which currently has a balance just over \$3,000.00. I of course will do that only with the Financial Committee approval. We did have a large travel bill that was due to Pastor Kyu for mileage & hotel for Annual Conference of over \$700.00 in June and our offerings are down a bit so far in June.

We do know that our new Pastor's salary and benefits are less that what we were paying so that should help us in July. With God's help it will all work out, as it always seems to.
