Financial Update through July 2025 - Totals are year to date:

Giving: \$71,611.37 Savings: \$1,500.00

Interest - Ess Investment: \$11,385.52 Total Income: \$84,496.89

Expenses: \$86,113.24 Difference: (\$1,626.35)

All bills were not paid thru July 2025 - we still owed \$1,145.00.

Comments on where we are through August 26th:

We are very tight on money at the end of August. I did have a very generous donor ask me how they could help and I do now have enough to pay everything current – just by about \$500.00 extra. The memorial committee agreed to pay \$2,290.00 of their undesignated money for July and August Pastor Retirement fund. The one thing we have not paid anything on is Mission Shares.

I try to remind myself when I get all worried about finances, it always seems to work out with our generous people and with God's help!
