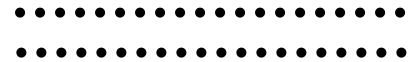

Dear Church family,

I have been thinking of Harvest of Gratitude this month a lot.

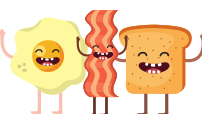
